

Campsite Rules Campingplatz Biehl

Dear camping guests,

We wish you a relaxing stay at Campingplatz Biehl and would like to make your time with us as pleasant as possible.

In the interest of all guests, we ask you to refrain from anything that could disturb the community and to observe the following campsite rules.

These site rules apply from 21/09/2026 until further notice, or until replaced by a new version.



1. Registration

Please register at reception before entering the campsite. Visitors are also asked to register before entering the site. If you check in via the self-service terminal outside reception opening hours, please report to reception the following morning. Our staff may inspect the ID of guests and visitors. Vehicles may only enter the site with a valid barrier card.

2. Access and Barrier

Access to the site is controlled by automatic barriers supported by an IT system. Every entry and exit, as well as number plates, are logged. The corresponding camera images of number plates are stored for the duration of your stay. By using the barrier card, you accept the terms of use.

3. Right to Refuse Entry

The instructions of our site management and site staff must be followed, in particular regarding the positioning of vehicles, caravans, awnings and similar structures.

In the event of violations of these site rules, the operator reserves the right, within the scope of its right to refuse entry, to terminate the camping contract, including without notice in serious cases. Site management is entitled to refuse admission to persons or to expel them from the site where this appears necessary.

4. Traffic and Parking

The German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) and a walking pace (5 km/h) apply across the entire campsite. This applies to all vehicles, including bicycles, e-scooters, motorcycles and mopeds. Please avoid unnecessary driving back and forth.

Cars may only be parked on your own pitch or in the designated parking areas. Please park your car or motorcycle beside or on your pitch in a way that does not obstruct traffic or neighbours. Only one car is permitted per caravan pitch.

5. Pitches, Awnings and Occupancy

Site management reserves the right to specify a fixed layout when setting up camping, caravan and other units. Only one camping vehicle is permitted per pitch.

The rented pitch is intended exclusively for personal use. Subletting or transferring the pitch to third parties is not permitted without the consent of site management.

Enclosing the pitch with trenches or fencing, or damaging the turf, is not permitted. To protect the lawn's ability to regenerate, no closed or air-tight tarpaulins, sheeting or other materials may be laid out. In the event of a violation, site management will charge the guest for the cost of restoring the lawn with turf rolls.

Guests must ensure that no one is endangered by tent pegs, guy lines, power cables or other tent and camping equipment. Crossing other guests' pitches is not permitted. Please use the designated paths, even if this means taking a detour.

6. Heaters, Air Conditioning and Generators

The use of mobile or additional electric heaters, as well as diesel heaters, is strictly prohibited across the entire site. In the event of a violation, the guest bears full liability for all damage and consequential costs, in particular for technician call-outs to resolve power faults and for repairing damaged infrastructure.

The use of air conditioning units (roof and split units) is generally permitted, provided this does not overload the electrical fuse of the respective pitch. To protect quiet hours, operation is not permitted between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am. Units must meet current technical standards and be operated so that no unreasonable noise nuisance is caused to neighbours. In the event of justified complaints from other guests, site management reserves the right to prohibit operation.

The use of mobile generators is not permitted anywhere on the site.

7. Dogs

Dogs of any size must be kept on a leash at all times across the entire site. Please remove your dog's waste immediately and completely and dispose of it properly. This also applies to urine on power cables etc. Dog waste bags are available free of charge at the red sanitary building.

8. Barbecues and Open Fires

Barbecuing is only permitted in designated grills; disposable barbecues are not allowed. Please watch out for flying sparks and keep embers under constant supervision. Liquid firelighters and accelerants are not permitted. Only fully cooled ash may be disposed of with residual waste.

Open fires, such as campfires, are not permitted.

9. Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any enclosed buildings on the campsite, in particular in the sanitary buildings.

The statutory provisions of the German Cannabis Act (KCanG) apply to the consumption of cannabis. Site management reserves the right, within the scope of its right to refuse entry, to prohibit the consumption of cannabis anywhere on the site.

10. Waste Disposal

Waste disposal is only permitted in the designated containers. Please observe correct waste separation. Disposal of bulky waste is not permitted. The waste and glass recycling containers are available to you daily from 08:00 to 18:00.

11. Quiet Hours

Quiet hours apply across the entire site between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am. During this time the barrier system is closed; driving on the site, including for arrivals and departures, is not possible. This applies to pitches both in front of and behind the barrier system.

Radios, televisions and similar devices may only be used so that nothing can be heard outside your unit. Please also avoid disturbing your neighbours with loud conversation or similar. We ask all guests to behave at all times in a way that does not disturb other guests. In the event of repeated or serious violations of quiet hours, immediate expulsion from the site may be ordered in accordance with Clause 3.

12. Liability and Damage

Please treat all facilities and equipment with care and leave them clean and tidy. Guests are liable for any damage they cause, as well as for damage caused by their equipment, installations or devices.

The operator accepts no liability for the loss or damage of guests' personal property, in particular through theft, unless the operator is guilty of intent or gross negligence. We recommend not leaving valuables unattended.

13. Electricity and Gas

The supply of electricity is only permitted in quantities customary for camping use. The guest is responsible for the proper connection from the electricity connection box onwards. Only intact, three-core connection cables with a CEE plug may be used. Charging electric vehicles at the pitch is not permitted.

Staying on the site is only permitted with vehicles that have a valid gas inspection; please have the valid inspection sticker ready for any checks. A maximum of two 11 kg gas bottles and two litres of flammable liquids may be stored per pitch.

Photovoltaic systems (e.g. plug-in balcony power stations) may only be operated as stand-alone, off-grid systems (e.g. a portable solar case with battery storage). Connection to the campsite's electricity grid, as well as any feed-in, is not permitted.

14. Arrival and Departure

Arrival is possible from 12:00 noon. Please plan your departure so that you leave the site by 10:30 am.
